Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2018-19 educational progress for the Lawton Middle School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. If you have any questions about the AER, please contact Tamara Webster for assistance.

For the 2018-19 school year, schools were identified using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given. Our school was not given one of these labels.

Using data from the Annual Education Report it was determined that we focus on the field of mathematics. One of the key ways Lawton Middle School is addressing this area is the creation of a multi-tier system of supports (MTSS). A collaborative group has been created this year to review options on how to properly support our students. Currently, each department is identifying essential standards that will help simplify and streamline the goals that our students need to achieve. In addition to this, Lawton Middle School will continue to provide peer tutoring during the school day and plan to develop more math interventions for future utilization.

State law requires that we also report additional information. Lawton Middle School accepts all resident students in grades six through eight as well as those students in grades six through eight accepted through the School of Choice Window. School of Choice students are accepted by application. Some resident students are assigned to attend county programs based on the decision of their IEP team. This is very rare.
