

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BID PROPOSALS:

Sealed proposals are invited for Pole Barn Installation Lawton Elementary School, Lawton, Michigan. All bids should be tax exempt. All applicable laws, ordinances, rules and regulations of all authorities having jurisdiction over the construction and renovation of a public school building shall apply to the contract throughout and to the project to be completed.

DUE DATE:

Proposals will be received until March 22nd, 2023, at 12:00 P.M. by delivery or mail to the office of Lawton Community Schools, 101 Primary Way, Lawton, Michigan 49065. Bids will be opened and read aloud publicly by a designee of Lawton Community Schools and its administrator at the above address immediately following the deadline for the receipt of bids. LATE BIDS/PROPOSALS WILL BE RETURNED UNOPENED.

PLANS:

Specifications are as follows. Site prep and installation of a 30'W x 48'L x 14'H (interior) pole barn structure.

1. Site Prep Area.
2. Build Structure including (1) 32" service door and (1) 12'x12' Garage Door, 12" over hang.
3. Install 4" Concrete/ fiber-mesh floor with brushed surface, 2' apron and 3'x3' service door pad.
4. Sand colored wall steel with TBD color steel Roof.
5. Ridge Vent
6. Give Optional quote for 10'T x 48'L x 12'W open lean to structure on south long wall

PROPOSAL GUARANTEE:

The proposal must be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond by an approved surety company in the amount of five percent (5%) of the proposal submitted. Proposals shall remain firm for a period of forty-five (45) days after official opening of bids. CONTRACT SECURITY: The successful Contractor will be required to furnish performance, labor and material bonds, each in the full amount of the proposal.

FAMILIAL RELATIONSHIPS:

The bid shall be accompanied by a sworn and notarized statement disclosing any familial relationship that exist between the owner or any employees of the bidder or any member of the Board of Lawton Community Schools, Superintendent of the school district; or any administrator of Lawton Community Schools.

IRAN AFFIDAVIT:

The bid shall be accompanied by a sworn and notarized statement pertaining to the IRAN ECONOMIC SANCTIONS ACT compliance of Michigan Public Act NO.512 of 2012.

IRAN ECONOMIC SANCTIONS ACT AFFIDAVIT OF COMPLIANCE

Michigan Public Act No. 517 of 2012

All Bids shall be accompanied by a sworn statement disclosing any Iran Linked Business relationship that exists within the owners, including its officers, directors and employees.

Moreover, any person who submitted a false certification shall be ineligible to bid on future Requests for Proposals (RFPs) for three (3) years from the date that it is determined that the person has submitted the false certification.
